RECREATION AREA RULES

Specific to Pools:

1. **Admission** to any Westwood Pool:
 - Hours are 10am – 8pm
 - Admission requires a current Recreation ID Card, when ID cards are not submitted to the monitor, you will not be allowed into the pool and its grounds for expulsion. The WWLOA, its employees, agents, or directors will always verify ID cards.
 - Admission is granted only if the cardholder is in good standing with the LOA office - no past due fees. Exception to this rule is if cardholder is on a verifiable payment plan (also in good standing)
2. **Children 13 and younger:**
 - Must be accompanied by a responsible caregiver over the age of 14.
 - The caregiver *must be listed on the application* and issued a Recreation ID.
 - An older sibling's Recreation ID must specify if they have permission to bring and care for siblings.
 - Max - 4 children (under the age of 14) per responsible adult/sibling/sitter.
3. **Guests:**
 - You are allowed 3 guests per household, and
 - You must be at least 18 years of age to bring a guest.
 - Members who have guests must remain with them at the pool and will be responsible for them. Failure to remain with guests is cause for expulsion & suspension of Recreation ID Card.
4. **Attire:**
 - Swim Attire ONLY permitted in pool.
 - Cut-off's jeans are NOT allowed – the threads damage filters
 - Approved "Swim diapers" must be worn by infants and toddlers to prevent accidents in the pool.
5. **Behavior Expectations:**
 - Keep it Safe - Diving, running, rough play, or other unsafe actions that endanger yourself or others is NOT permitted.
 - Gated pool areas are smoke-free areas. Smoking is not allowed.
 - On busy days, the WWLOA, its employees, agents, or directors will have the discretion to limit an activity which may cause injury or inconvenience to others (including nerf balls, rafts, inner tubes, or noodles).
 - Hitting other swimmers is not allowed and will result in loss of pool privileges.
 - No water balloons nor hard objects, such as tennis balls, Frisbees, etc., will be allowed to be thrown in the pool area, and fighting over any toys is not permitted
 - Fighting or abusive language will result in loss of pool privileges.
6. **Pool Emergency Call Box:**
 - An emergency call box is located at each pool house and shall only be used when 911 must be dispatched.
7. **Disagreements:**
 - Any disagreement with the WWLOA, its employees or agents' judgement should be represented to the WWLOA Board of Directors at a later date. **The WWLOA, its employees, or agents have the authority to terminate all pool privileges for a period of 24 hours.** Second offense will result in termination of pool privileges for a period of 7 days. Third offense will result in termination of pool privileges for the remainder of the pool season. However, the WWLOA reserves the right to take further action on the first or second offense if the offense is considered egregious. These rules will benefit all who use the pool facilities only if every resident cooperates. **Landowner agrees that pool privileges may be suspended immediately if any regular or special assessment becomes delinquent.**

Other Recreation Areas (Tennis Courts, Basketball Courts, Pavilion, Parks, and Parking Lots):

8. **Hours for areas other than pools are Dawn until Dusk (Daylight hours only)**
9. **Admission to non-pool recreation areas:**
- Must have a valid recreation ID to use recreation areas
 - Westwood Landowners are limited to 5 guests per household in these areas and the Landowner must accompany guests at any facility.

ALL Recreation Areas:

10. **Other Important Recreation Rules (in addition to rules to specific areas):**
- No Weapons of any kind in any recreation area.
 - No GLASS containers allowed in any recreation area
 - No Alcohol allowed in any recreation area
 - Food and/or drinks may be consumed in the picnic areas and benches ONLY
 - No Pets permitted in pool areas, any sports courts, or gated areas
 - No loud music in recreation areas.
 - No offensive language – this applies to both speaking and music lyrics
 - No Lewd or disrespectful behavior
 - No paid lessons at any recreation facilities
 - No bicycles, skateboards, or roller blades permitted in gated areas.
 - Use bike racks and
 - Do not block or create obstacles to entryways.
 - NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES IN AREAS OTHER THAN PAVED PARKING AREAS

Additional Pool Information:

- **Pool Composition:**
 - Westwood's pools are made of gunite plaster. This type of surface can skin toes or feet if a person has been in the water more than 30 minutes. Parents might want to consider aqua socks for children. I understand that it is recommended that swimmers wear protective footwear and exercise pool safety considering the composition of the pool areas.
- **Pool Closures:**
 - I understand WWLOA pools may close for the following:
 - Bad weather
 - Vandalism
 - Chemical problems
 - Any other reason that WWLOA deems necessary
